### Nursery

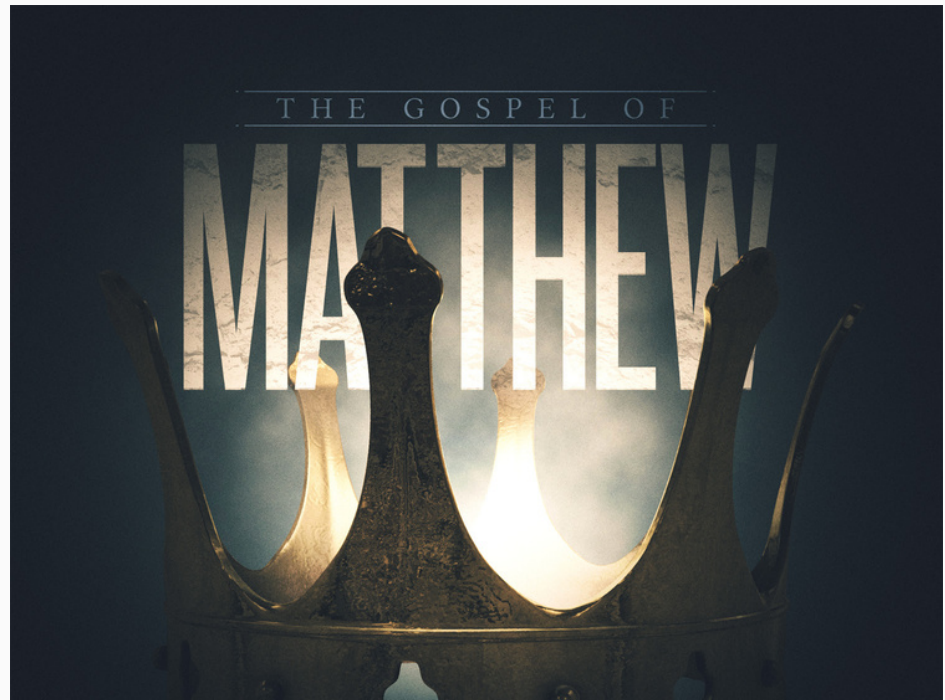
Nursery is provided at the start of the service for infants through the age of 3, and is located in the fellowship hall basement.
